Prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (revised edition) by specifying that there will be a drive To carry out important reform activities (Big Rock) Reform activity number 4: Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent without Benefits for which the goal is number 1.1: “Every government agency shall declare itself to be an agency that All government officials do not accept gifts and souvenirs of any kind while performing their duties (No Gift Policy)

In order to drive forward activities according to the national reform plan above, which creates Transparency within the agency Create values in performing duties and relying on practices to become an honest culture of Nongphanchan Subdistrict Therefore, a policy has been announced for all executives, employees, officials, and personnel in the organization not to accept And do not give gifts and gifts of all kinds from performing duties (No Gift Policy) on every festival and occasion. Various special circumstances, unless necessary and unavoidable Follow the rules for receiving gifts or presents and Any other benefits according to the regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by government officials, 2023, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission regarding the criteria for receiving Property or any other benefits based on the ethics of government officials, B.E. 2024

Is therefore announced for everyone's acknowledgment and strict adherence to the policy.
